

As it is known, the reason for this process is the filtering of glass particles spilled from the ampules and any foreign substances that may arise from the medicine.

However, if the risk analysis of the spinal region and the epidural region is to be performed, it will be appreciated that the spinal region is much more risky. While this is the case, there is no filtration in the anesthetic injection to the spinal region.
